We are happy to report that we do not have any cases of COVID-19 at Oliver Lodge.

Outdoor visits - have been a success! Despite the cooler weather and the rain, visits this week were well received. Here are a few more questions and answers in case others are also wondering the same thing.

- 1. Do I need to wear a mask?** You are asked to wear a mask if you have been outside of Saskatchewan in the past 14 days, been in non-close contact with someone with Covid-19, or have attended a mass gathering of 15 or more. Otherwise, wearing a mask is not mandatory.
- 2. Is there a limit to how many visitors can attend?** There is not a set limit. We have areas that can accommodate large groups of visitors. Visitors are responsible for their own social distancing. It is very helpful to us if you are able to provide us with the number of visitors that will be attending. We do our best to make sure that there is a chair available for each visitor.
- 3. Can I visit if I am from out of province?** Yes. If you are from out of province and have not been in Saskatchewan for 14 days, you are required to wear a mask during your visit.
- 4. I am only available to visit on a certain day because I have the day off/ I'm travelling from out of town/etc. Is this possible?** The more notice you are able to provide the better your chances are. We do our best to meet the needs of the visitors, the residents, and Oliver Lodge as we realize how important these visits are to everyone.
- 5. What if the weather is poor?** As Saskatchewan weather goes, we never really know what the weather will be until it is here. We will keep our eye on the forecast and make the best judgment we can. In the case of inclement weather, the visit will be relocated and you will be directed when you arrive. Some visits may need to be rescheduled and we will contact you. If you do not hear from us, the visit is still as planned.

- 6. Can we bring our dog?** Dogs are a welcomed addition to the visit. We do ask that the dog remains on a leash and that you bring water, etc. for the dog. Unfortunately, your loved one will not be able to pet the dog.

Life at Oliver Lodge – The residents are being loved and cared for by all of our amazing staff. All staff are going above and beyond to bring life and excitement to the residents' daily lives. The residents are involved with caring for their gardens and flowers, playing games, watching videos and partaking in virtual music programs as well as Rev. Darren's performances. We had taken a "vacation" from posting the monthly recreation calendars, but we are returning to making sure that they are posted each month.
