Emails – Please send your letters and pictures to your loved one to oliverlodgespecialcarehome@gmail.com. These letters are printed off each business day and delivered to the residents.

Item Drop-off and Deliveries – The item drop-off cart is available in the front entrance. Items will be quarantined for a minimum of 24 hours. Please ensure that perishable food items are placed in a wipable container in order for it to be sanitized and delivered as soon as possible. All other items will be delivered to your loved ones Monday-Friday after being quarantined. Anything dropped off after 12:00pm on Friday will not be delivered until Monday. All items are left at your own risk.

There have been many questions surrounding this outbreak. Many of the answers are not the answers we want to hear but they are the answers from the Saskatchewan Health Authority that we need to follow. These decisions are made with your loved one's safety at the forefront.

The question that gets asked the most is: **“Were the infected individuals vaccinated for COVID-19?”**

Vaccination is the best tool we have to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 as well as preventing or minimizing COVID-19 symptoms and be effective in avoiding hospitalization or critical illness. However, no one can be forced to complete any medical treatment without consent or statutory authorization. Oliver Lodge does, however, encourage vaccination on a voluntary basis.

It is every individual's right to confidentiality and privacy to any health information collected about them and is limited to the individuals who require it. Oliver Lodge is not privy to this information nor are we able to share that information if it becomes available.
