**Oliver Lodge is on a COVID-19 suspect outbreak on  
1<sup>st</sup> floor, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, and Oliver Lodge South  
with hopes of it being declared over as of August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**

Compassionate and end of life visits will be permitted on 1<sup>st</sup> floor, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, and Oliver Lodge South. **All residents at Oliver Lodge qualify for compassionate visits.** If a visit will assist in the quality of life of your loved one, a compassionate visit is appropriate. **These visits do not need to be prearranged.** Please limit visitors to a maximum of two at a time with a resident. Face shields will be required along with the medical grade masks and they will be provided for you when you arrive at Oliver Lodge.

Residents residing on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor are not on suspect outbreak and are able to have unlimited visitors at this time.

### **Current Visiting Guidelines**

- We do ask that you refrain from visiting during mealtimes.
- Please physical distance when possible.
- All visitors will complete the COVID-19 screening and are required to sign in.
- Hand hygiene must be completed when entering and leaving the home.
- A medical grade mask and face shield, if required, will be provided on arrival. **The mask is expected be worn properly at all times** (over the nose and under the chin).
- Visitors are not permitted to bring in food and/or beverages for themselves to consume during the visit as masks are expected to remain on during the visit.

- **Visits will occur in the resident's room.** Visitors will be required to go directly to and from the resident's room. Access to the common areas such as outdoor patios on the community, community kitchenettes, living and dining rooms and other communal spaces is not permitted.
- **Oliver Place tenants** – you may enter Oliver Lodge through the Linkage access. Please proceed directly to security at the main entrance to complete your screening and sign-in prior to visiting your loved one.
- Visitor washroom is located on the main floor across from the Business Office beside the elevator.

**Virtual Visits** – all virtual visits moving forward are cancelled unless they have recently been prearranged by Recreation or Spiritual Care. Please feel free to provide your loved one with an in-person compassionate visit as stated above.

The Saskatchewan Health Authority's Medical Health Officers will continue to monitor COVID-19 in our communities (case numbers, outbreaks and vaccination rates). If needed, they will re-introduce restrictions based on the level of community transmission and the number of cases within a home. If any changes are made, we will be in touch to explain the impacts to family presence.
