Reminder of the Oliver Lodge Visiting Guidelines:

- All visitors must provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination (2 weeks post 2nd dose) or present a negative Covid-19 PCR or Antigen test result taken with the last 72 hours from an approved third-party provider (PCR or Antigen).
- One piece of photo ID or two pieces of non-photo ID will also be required.

- Visits will take place in the resident's room.
- Masking is required at **ALL** times by visitors. This includes wearing a mask while in the resident's room – even when the door is closed.
- **Visitors are not allowed to consume food or beverages during their visit** as masks must remain on during the entire visit.
- **Visiting Hours:**
 - Monday-Friday → 1:30pm-7:00pm (must screened in by 7:00pm)
 - Saturday & Sunday → 9:30am-7:00pm (must screened in by 7:00pm)
 - Statutory Holidays → 9:30am-7:00pm (must screened in by 7:00pm)

Locking of the Front Entrance – The front entrance sliding doors will be locked during certain times of the day/night for the safety of staff and residents.
